The new Rough Guide to Accessible Britain contains details of over 175 of the UK's best attractions catering for disabled people. The free guide features everything from the Scottish Gliding Centre for 'walking on air' experiences, to shopping in London's Spitalfields market for British holidaymakers and day trippers regardless of their mobility or accessibility considerations. Developed by Rough Guides in association with Motability Operations - the company that manages the car scheme for disabled people in the UK - the Rough Guide to Accessible Britain is now in its second year. It was compiled by an army of disabled writers across the country, as well as readers of the first edition of the guide who answered a call from the publishers to give details of their favourite days out.

The Rough Guide to Accessible Britain has taken onboard feedback from the first edition (published in April 2008) and is now arranged into geographical regions that are easier to navigate. The guide includes more hidden and off-the-beaten track attractions, and features additional ideas such as bars and restaurants to make the most of a day out.
